## **BREAKFAST CLUB at St Stephen's C of E First School.**

Dear Parents and Carers,

If you are a parent or grandparent of a child that uses our breakfast club, we are having to make a few changes. From April 13<sup>th</sup>, which is the first Monday after the Easter Holidays, we can no longer accept children who attend our Nursery.

The reason for this change is that we do not receive funding for Nursery children, which means that we cannot afford to pay for the extra staff that are required when supporting Nursery pupils.

If you still wish to attend the breakfast club with your Nursery child, you are very welcome, but you will need to stay with your child until Breakfast Club finishes at 8:40am. Then a member of staff will let you out of the hall and take your child down to the Nursery classroom.

We are sorry for the inconvenience that this might cause, but we are following the Governments guidelines.

Our Breakfast Club continues to grow and at present there are between 60 and 70 children. As a result, we need to remind the children of the Breakfast Club rules, for their health and safety. These are listed below. We would appreciate it if you could read through these with your child. If your child does not adhere to these rules, they may not be allowed to attend the club.
